



Game Stores Case Study



When GAME Stores needed to create additional space at their Head office in Basingstoke, they turned to CBS for assistance with space-planning and furniture supply.

This provision of new office facilities followed the original relocation from Bracknell several years ago, again with the support of CBS.

Mark Tuley, International Group Property Development Manager said:

"Having worked with CBS the first time around, we were confident they could supply the service we required. The whole process went very smoothly, with everything now in place to support our immediate and future growth plans."

With staff relocating from other offices and the need to recruit further staff to support new business growth, GAME acknowledged additional office space was required.

CBS were commissioned to manage the move, provide space planning and supply new office furniture.

This entailed the removal of 11 meeting rooms to make way for the additional desks, and the conversion of space set aside at the time of the original move to allow for future expansion. In addition, extra office space was taken in a nearby building and fitted out to provide meeting room space and further desk space.

A key requirement in the refitting and supply of furniture was to match the original designs.

Other ancillary works, including the expansion of the bistro-style dining area to cater for the increased head-count, have since been completed, bringing the project to a successful conclusion.
